<ul> <li>If your Zombie coworker asks to borrow a stapler or other office supplies:</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Lend them what they need and help them requisition more supplies if the process is complicated or confusing.</li> </ul>	• Ask them how they intend to open your skull with a stapler.
At the company picnic:	<ul> <li>Offer to share some sunscreen with your Zombie officemate, as the hot sun can be hard on the Differently Animated.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Confuse them with a Vampire and demand to know how they walk in the daylight without bursting into flames.</li> </ul>
On your Zombie Co-Worker's Birthday:	<ul> <li>Consider a card or a small baked good, while being aware some Zombies celebrate their Reanimation Day instead.</li> </ul>	• Wrap a shovel up in a big red bow and offer to drive them back 'home' to the cemetary for the party.
• When Communicating Via Office Email or Other Official Means:	<ul> <li>Show sensitivity by avoiding potentially loaded terms like 'Walking Dead'</li> </ul>	• Use terms like 'stench', 'shambler', 'lurker' or other hurtful slang
On 'Bring Your Child to Work Day':	Greet the Zombie child in a friendly manner and ask them where they attend school	<ul> <li>Respond by screaming 'They're multiplying!' or by barricading yourself in your office/cubicle to wait out the 'Zombie Apocalypse'</li> </ul>
